Here's what you need to know!

## REGISTRATION TIPS & FAQ

### Who is my advisor?

Coles College students are assigned an advisor(s) based on major. This is your go-to source for navigating your academic career. Our advisors specialize in the degree programs and stay connected to the academic departments to better serve you.

### How many classes should I take?

It depends on what works for you.

Here are some options:

- 12 hours/4 classes (full-time enrollment)  
~ 5 years to graduation
- 15 hours/semester ~ 4 years to graduation
- Consider summer classes as you plan to maintain momentum and graduate on time

### What if a class I need is full?

Registration will remain open through the summer. In the meantime, choose another course needed for your program to get full-time enrollment, and keep trying. Students often change their schedules in the first week of classes. You may also add your name to the wait-list for a course (if available), please note that placement is not guaranteed.

### How does math placement work?

Placement begins with SAT/ACT scores (if submitted) and your high school GPA. Since there are a variety of unique situations, talk to your advisor for guidance and additional information.

### What if I have AP or Dual Enrollment credits?

Let your advisor know. If they already appear on your KSU transcript, we can help you find the next course to take now. If not, you can add classes when the scores/classes have arrived.
