Part B: Alignment with Mission, Expected Outcomes, and Strategy

Our portfolio is well aligned with our mission statement and strategy, though there is room for improvement. Our mission focuses on value to students and the business and academic communities, so one would expect us to have ample representation across all three types of intellectual contributions. Our contributions are weighted more heavily toward basic/discovery scholarship which serves each of those constituencies, but emphasizes the academic community. Such emphasis was particularly important as we initiated a doctoral program. Pursuit

of such scholarship has improved our reputation in the academic community. In the past five years, our applied intellectual contributions were about one-third of our portfolio. While that is a significant portion of our portfolio, as we engage business more, we expect that percentage to increase to further demonstrate our relevance to the business community. Teaching and Learning Scholarship at 15-20% serves our students at an ample level.

- 1) Peer-Reviewed Journal Articles published in Journals ranked as A or A+ by our College. Each department has strong representation of faculty publishing in their disciplines' best journals. This clearly demonstrates high quality and impact in academic circles.
- 2) List of Editors, Associate Editors and Editorial Board Members of Journals and List of those who have been asked to review articles for their disciplines' best journals. Again, a broad cross-section of each department is providing significant impact to the intellectual development of their disciplines.
- 3) Journal Articles with significant citations: This demonstrates that other authors in their disciplines are citing our faculty's works. A clear impact is demonstrated on the body of knowledge in their fields.
- 4) Leadership Positions in Academic and/or Professional Organizations: The broad array of faculty who hold numerous positions that engage both the academic and business community clearly demonstrates the impact our faculty is having on those constituencies.
- 5) Recognition for Research: A number of our faculty have won Best Paper and Organizational Awards for their research; another indicator of impact and quality.
