Welcome Dr. Stacy Campbell

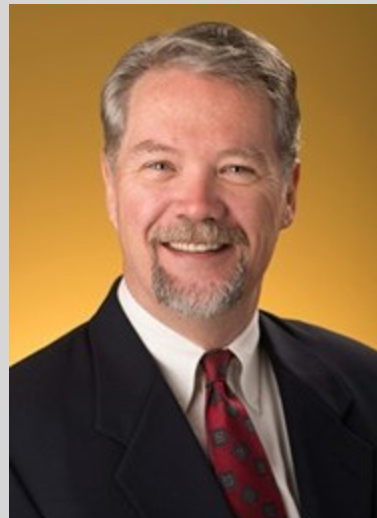
Interim Director
